





INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

Simply plug the SafetyCell into your aircraft's standard headset and microphone jacks. Next, plug your headset and cell phone into

the SafetyCell.

In a matter of seconds, you will have simultaneous use of your cell phone AND your aircraft radio. At all times, you will hear the caller and radio transmissions.

Answer phone calls as you normally would. When you reply to a cell phone call, simply talk into your headset microphone. No need to put your cell phone to your ear.

Simply dial the number on your phone's dial pad. When your party answers, talk through your headset microphone. If you wish to talk over the radio, push your push-to-talk switch as usual.

In the event of radio failure, the SafetyCell provides an additional measure of safety for all pilots whether VFR or IFR.

The SafetyCell also aids pilots in: filing flight plans, getting IFR clearance at uncontrolled airstrips, arranging for a tie down, calling for a rental car, checking with the office, adjusting appointment schedules or simply confirming dinner plans with your spouse.

You can easily use a portable tape recorder in place of your cell phone and use it as a cockpit voice recorder and/or ATC instruction recorder.

Or, you can listen to your favorite music while still hearing all radio transmissions.

Always ready to go, the SafetyCell requires no batteries or power source. Stow in your flight bag and move it from plane to plane. You'll never be left stranded.
